How to HELP a Stray or Feral Cat: Trap • Neuter • Return (TNR)

CARE Feline TNR Can Help!

1. Provide food and water every day
2. Provide shelter from cold and heat
3. **TNR:** Trap to get cat fixed - population control
4. Return cats back to their original territory or find a friendly home for them

CARE Feline TNR offers a program with **low-cost or free options for you.**

- CARE will loan you humane traps if needed for those feral/wild cats that can't be caught by hand. Traps are painless and won't harm.
- CARE will give you instructions on how to trap and care for the cat during this time.
- CARE will make an appointment for you at a partnered vet clinic.
- Cat receives spay/neuter, vaccines, pain meds & more
- A small part of the ear is clipped at the top. "Ear-tip", a universal symbol of a spayed/neutered feral cat.
- The cat is picked up by you and released back to where you trapped it AFTER recovery.
